- Idaho’s congressional delegation returns to Washington, DC with a better understanding of the benefits of the CHIP program for Idaho’s poorest children.
- An elderly man from Burma can see clearly and learns to read with his first pair of glasses.
- A child from Eritrea can enjoy the waters of Boise without fear after learning to swim.
- Preschoolers experience new fresh vegetables from refugee farmers and see how they grow.
- A new, thriving ethnic restaurant brings self-sufficiency to a family because they received a Jannus small business loan to open their dream business.
- A family is warm and safely housed after losing their home during the Boise River flooding.
- A woman in turmoil attends a caregiving class and connects in a meaningful way with her mother days before she passes.
